

Information on How to Report Concerns about Radicalisation

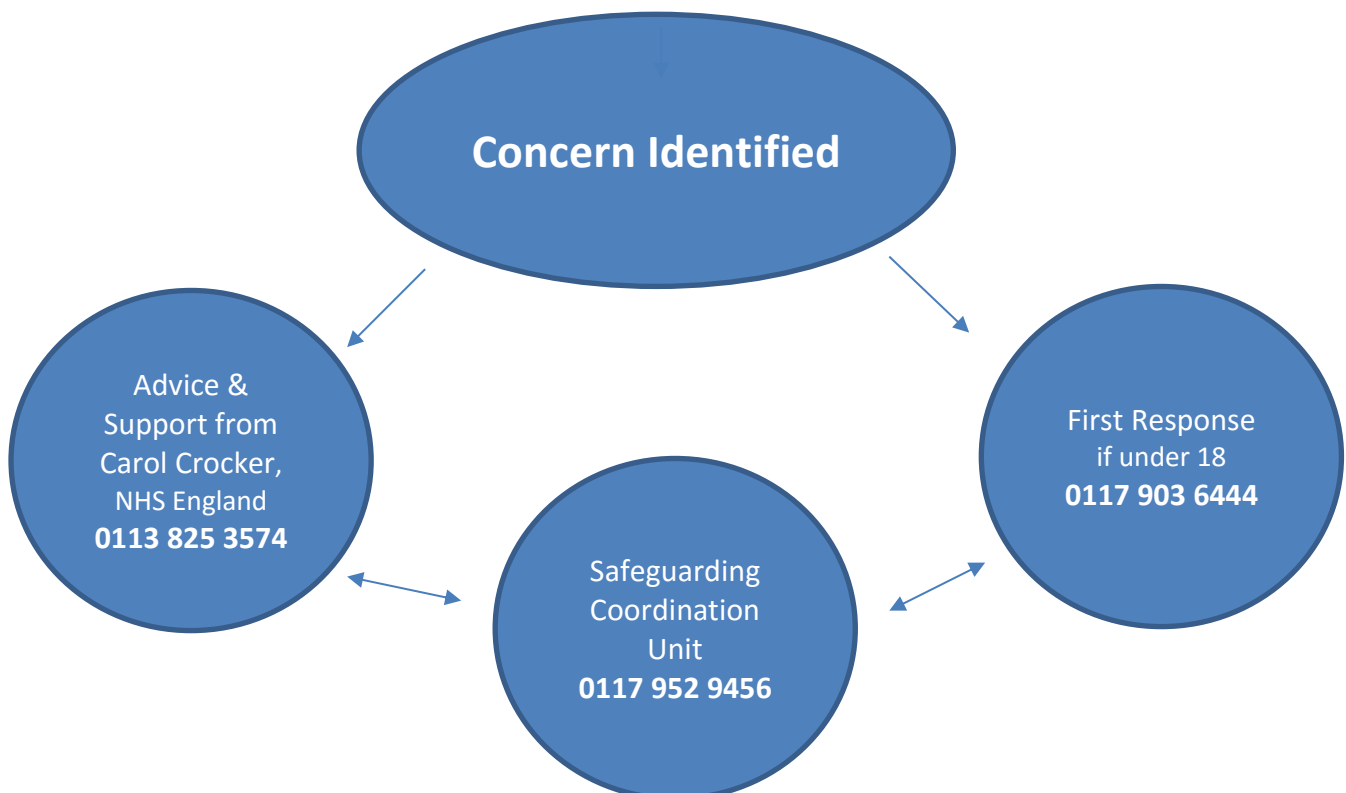
GPs should have training on the Prevent Agenda to help them identify young people or adults at risk of radicalisation. To access training, please contact Carole Crocker (telephone contact details below).

There have been a number of high profile cases where young people have left the country, one of the cases involving a Bristol girl called Yusra Hussein, aged 15, who may have left to become a “jihadi bride”.

These cases will need a referral to both Safeguarding Children First Response, **0117 903 6444**, and the Police Safeguarding Coordination Unit, **0117 952 9456**

The police will sensitively review information with their own intelligence through their special teams under the channel process. You may not get feedback from this process, but please update them if there are new concerns or worries.
